## **Homeless Shelters**

Homeless shelters provide a safe place for our neighbors facing a housing crisis. Along with shelter, participants receive access to basic needs and supportive services designed to help stabilize their situation and connect them to additional resources. These programs create a secure living environment where people can begin taking the next steps toward independence and stability.



## **Affordable Housing Solutions**

A New Leaf offers long-term affordable housing opportunities that help our neighbors achieve lasting stability and independence. Residents are provided with homes where they can feel financially secure and focus on improving their lives. A New Leaf offers a wide range of housing and shelter programs designed to meet people where they are and support long-term stability. From emergency shelter and affordable housing to rental assistance and supportive services, these programs help individuals and families build safer, more secure futures.

### East Valley Men's Center

**2345 N Country Club Dr, Mesa, AZ 85201**

Provides shelter and support services to single men.

### La Mesita Apartments

**2254 W Main St, Mesa, AZ 85201**

Permanent affordable apartments for low-income families.

### Desert Leaf Apartments

**44 S Horne, Mesa, AZ 85204**

Permanent supportive housing for people experiencing homelessness, domestic violence or severe mental illness.

### Rapid ReHousing

**Operates Valley-wide**

Provides financial assistance, case management and support services to families and individuals living in emergency shelters.

### Tenant Based Rental Assistance

**Operates in Maricopa County**

Rental assistance program for those who are currently homeless, offering rental subsidies, utility/security deposits, and more.

### Thunderbird Apartments

**2302 West Colter Street, Phoenix, AZ 85015**

Offers over 70 housing units for low-income households. Units are 2-bedroom and amenities are offered onsite.

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
